Outsider Art Fair Announces 2013 Exhibitors, Complete With a Few Surprises



The Outsider Art Fair, which dealer Andrew Edlin acquired last year, released the list of exhibitors for its 2013 edition, and it includes a few dealers you might not expect to be doing the fair, like New York's Laurel Gitlen, a Lower East Side gallery focused primarily on contemporary art, which is sharing a booth with the Brussels contemporary gallery Sorry We're Closed. Vito Schnabel has also

grabbed a booth.
