Get your maverick folk art vibe on and diversify up your aesthetic leanings with **Outsider Art Fair**, which returns to shake up New York at the end of January, for its 21st anniversary.

The fair, which has become a cornerstone of the "outsider, self-taught and folk art" scene for both collectors and dealers, exhibits work from long-standing and new artists in the field, and although the majority of exhibitors are U.S.-based, a global tint arises courtesy of galleries from Japan, Haiti, Switzerland and the UK.

Expect to see mosaics, drawings carvings, sculpture, skateboard decks and a lot of unusual pieces which all curve refreshingly away from established art boundaries.

Outsider Art Fair 2013 takes place at Center548 from January 31 to February 3.
